Demolition Continues

Another building at the site along 183rd Street will start to be demolished soon as crews also continue their abatement clean-up in other buildings throughout the 280 acres of vacant land. See photos of buildings already demolished on site <u>here</u>.



Oversight

Independent oversight of the cleanup continues at the site. A third-party company monitoring the air ensures the safety of the workers and the surrounding community, and multiple layers of government continue to oversee the project, including the county, state and federal levels, through site visits, permitting, and routine documentation and reporting review.



Stay In The Know

This site is being cleaned up using only state grant funds because it was owned by the state of Illinois for many decades. The state chose the Park District to finally clean up this property and be responsible stewards of the grant funding. We're doing just that, without asking our residents to foot the bill!
