

RESOLUTION NO 26-R-22

A RESOLUTION TO ACCEPT THE ADA AUDIT AND TRANSITION PLAN

WHEREAS, the Tinley Park-Park District is located in Cook & Will Counties of Illinois; and

WHEREAS, the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990 (ADA) requires public entities with responsibility over public facilities and programs to evaluate accessibility, identify barriers to access, and develop a transition plan for achieving compliance with applicable accessibility standards; and

WHEREAS, the Tinley Park-Park District has completed a comprehensive evaluation of its parks, facilities, programs, services, and public rights-of-way to identify accessibility improvements and establish priorities for barrier removal; and

WHEREAS, the ADA Transition Plan provides a comprehensive inventory of existing facilities, identifies barriers to accessibility, establishes recommendations and priorities for improvements, and serves as a planning document to guide future accessibility projects and compliance efforts; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners recognizes the importance of providing parks, recreation programs, facilities, and services that are accessible to all members of the community and is committed to implementing the ADA Transition Plan as funding and resources become available; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the Tinley Park-Park District finds that it is in the best interest of the District to accept the ADA Transition Plan as presented.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Commissioners of the TINLEY PARK-PARK DISTRICT as follows:

SECTION 1: The Preambles hereto are hereby made a part of, and an operative provision of, this Resolution as if fully restate herein.

SECTION 2: The ADA Transition Plan attached hereto as Exhibit 1, and made a part hereof, is hereby accepted as presented. The ADA Transition Plan shall serve as the District's guiding document for identifying and prioritizing accessibility improvements, recognizing that implementation of individual projects shall remain subject to future Board approval, available funding, and applicable legal requirements.

SECTION 3: That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect on the date approved and passed by the Board of Commissioners of the TINLEY PARK-PARK DISTRICT.
