

RESOLUTION NO 26-R-23

A RESOLUTION APPOINTING ADA COORDINATOR

WHEREAS, the Tinley Park-Park District is located in Cook & Will Counties of Illinois; and

WHEREAS, the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990 (ADA) requires public entities to designate at least one employee to coordinate the Agency's efforts to comply with and carry out its responsibilities under the Act; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners recognizes the importance of ensuring that District programs, services, activities, facilities, and communications are accessible to individuals with disabilities and are administered in accordance with applicable federal and state laws; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners desires to designate an ADA Coordinator to oversee the District's compliance with the Americans with Disabilities Act, coordinate accessibility initiatives, assist with the implementation of the District's ADA Transition Plan, respond to requests for reasonable accommodations, and serve as the District's point of contact for ADA-related matters; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners finds that the Superintendent of Parks possesses the knowledge, experience, and operational oversight necessary to effectively fulfill the responsibilities of the ADA Coordinator; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the Tinley Park-Park District finds that it is in the best interest of the District to appoint the Superintendent of Parks as the District's ADA Coordinator.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Commissioners of the TINLEY PARK-PARK DISTRICT as follows:

SECTION 1: The Preambles hereto are hereby made a part of, and an operative provision of, this Resolution as if fully restate herein.

SECTION 2: The Superintendent of Parks is hereby appointed as the ADA Coordinator for the Tinley Park-Park District and is authorized to perform all duties and

responsibilities necessary to administer and coordinate the District's compliance with the Americans with Disabilities Act and other applicable accessibility laws and regulations. The appointment shall remain in effect until a successor is appointed by the Board of Commissioners.

SECTION 3: That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect on the date approved and passed by the Board of Commissioners of the TINLEY PARK-PARK DISTRICT.
